Guide to Purposeful Language

Communicate your heart in estate documents



Most legal documents lay out for beneficiaries, executors, and trustees how the Grantor desires his or her financial assets to be distributed.

Most documents do not include any language regarding the parents' deep and heartfelt values, hopes, dreams, and intentions for the wealth they are passing on.

Many clients would like to include some language regarding their love for their heirs, their own personal values, their faith, and the purposes they hope to see accomplished with the wealth. We call that "Purposeful Language."

When we assist a client in writing the purposeful language they want to include in their documents, we encourage them to put it in their own words. Our clients' own words are the most eloquent and effective expressions of their deepest purposes, hopes, and dreams.

Some characteristics of this purposeful language include:

1. It is written in first person.

If you are creating three trusts, you make each one personal to the specific beneficiary.

- 2. It captures the voice of the trust creator.
- 3. It includes some positive thoughts that the parent expresses about the beneficiary.

A child's awareness of the positive emotion their parent had at the time of making a gift has profound influence on the child's ability to feel deep gratitude for the gift.

- 4. It includes a statement regarding their love for their child.
- 5. It includes a statement of the parents' relationship to God and His role in their lives.
- 6. It includes their hopes and dreams for their children.
- 7. It is no longer than one page.

Ideas and Examples

Below are suggestions for including positive thoughts about your children, followed by several examples of document introductions.

Suggestions for creating and writing positive thoughts about your children:

- 1. Reflections about the day you were born
- 2. How we chose your name and what it meant to us
- 3. Memories of trips or vacations when we created priceless memories
- 4. Things I have always admired about you
- 5. Special talents or gifts I feel you have been given and the great potential I have seen in you
- 6. Really difficult challenges I have seen you overcome and how I felt about your effort
- 7. Things you said or did for me which really made me feel special or loved
- 8. How I felt when you passed important milestones such as a graduation, your first big job, etc.
- 9. Favorite quotes or life lessons I think may be important to you or your children in the future
- 10. A favorite life Bible verse that has led and encouraged you through life
